West Patton Village 2022-2023 Infrastructure Project:

Q & D Construction is currently replacing roads and driveway aprons. THE ROADS IN WPV WILL GET WORSE BEFORE THEY GET BETTER! All curbs and driveway aprons will be complete by September 26th. They will be done with grinding the roads and preparing them for pavement by September 30th.

- Pavement of all of West Patton Village Roads will be completed October 2-6th, 2023. During this week you will not be able to drive or park on your street between 7 am and 5pm. No Parking Cones will be out and you will be towed at your own expense. \$500.00 a tow plus \$60.00 a day storage. If you need special consideration, please call the office and let us know what dates that will be.
 - Extra Connections in Hillcrest and Mt. View will be completed Oct 16th 30th.
- All yard repairs from construction will be completed Oct 10th 30th, if your yard is not complete by this time or you have items of repair, please call the office and let us know so we can put you on the list to double check before contractors leave our area in November.
- Please drive slowly through the neighborhood for the safety of the contractors, children and yourself. Construction will continue all summer, so please be patient and considerate to one another. Completion estimated 11/01/2023

FACTS: Project estimated cost \$13,426,600.00. Water and Sewer are SRF (State Revolving Fund) Grant.

-County and HPUD have a 7 foot easement from the sidewalk into each yard.

RATE:

The Community approved rate changes for this project and the State Funding with Resolution 2019-03 and Resolution 2019-04 on September 17, 2019. The new rates will take affect on the **October 23rd billing**. Water facility charge will be \$84.03 plus \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used. Sewer charge will be \$65.62 monthly.
